# Notice of Board Opening

**District 3 SWCD Supervisor – Hibbing/Chisholm/Balkan & two unorganized townships**

The North St. Louis Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) Board of Supervisors is seeking to fill an open board supervisor position from nomination district 3 covering the areas of Hibbing, Chisholm, Balkan Township and unorganized townships 59-21 and 55-21. (Please see [www.nslswcd.org](http://www.nslswcd.org) for a service area map). This term expires 1/7/19.

SWCDs are local units of government that carry out natural resource management programs at the local level. We provide voluntary, incentive-driven approaches to landowners for better soil and cleaner water in the State of Minnesota. Private landowners – using financial and technical assistance from local [SWCDs](#) – are implementing a wide variety of conservation practices including restoring wetlands, reducing soil erosion, and preventing invasive species.

Recent highlights of our work include removing and replacing riprap on a severely eroding shoreline on the Whiteface Reservoir; improving trout habitat on the Bulldog Hanson Creek and Lost River near Orr and implementing a watercraft inspection program on Lake Vermilion.

SWCD Board Supervisors play an important role in determining how soil and water resources are managed within our county. They work cooperatively with local, state, and federal partners to establish soil and water conservation policy. SWCD's serve as a focal point for identifying and addressing natural resource issues. Supervisor activities include monthly board meetings and periodic training sessions, strategic planning, and committee meetings. Supervisors receive a \$75 per diem and mileage/expense reimbursement for their service.

SWCD Board Supervisors hold a public office and are permitted time off from regular employment to attend meetings. The time off may be without pay, with pay, or made up with other hours, as agreed between the employee and employer.

Meetings are currently held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 10:30 a.m. in Virginia.

If you reside within the boundaries of nomination district 3 and are interested in serving as a North St. Louis Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor, please complete and submit an application form. 6. Will you actively serve on SWCD committees? If so, what types of committees are of interest to you?
