- Students must be in **grades 4-6**.
- Posters must be created by the student and reflect and include the title of this year's contest theme "*Where would be Bee without Pollinators.*"
- Poster size can range from 8.5" x 11" up to 12" x 18".
- Students may use paint, crayons, pencils, stickers, markers, or whatever inspires them to create the poster.
- Clearly print student's name, grade, teacher, and school on back of poster.
- \*\*\*Posters that feature how our pollinators influence water may be featured in the "We Are Water" Exhibit hosted at the Minnesota Discovery Center April 16 - June 15, 2020.
