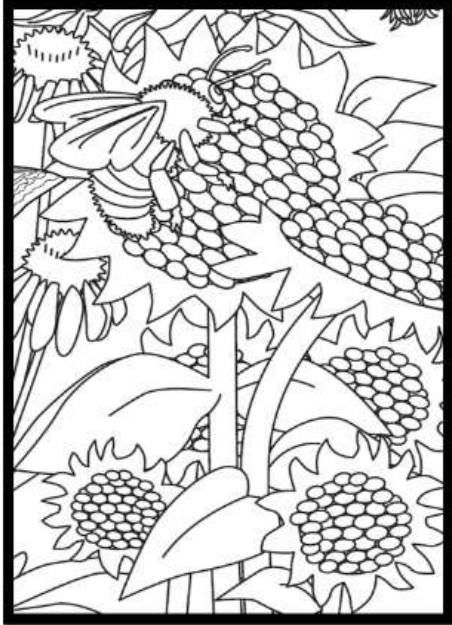


# Take part in the 2020 Conservation Coloring Contest!
