Minnesota has the 3<sup>rd</sup> oldest forests in the nation, much of this is due to the inability to harvest as much as in past years roughly two million acres, down from 5 million. Part of this is dues to a decline of loggers and reduced demand for spruce and balsam. There are new products in development that need EPA approval: wood pellets and a liquid fuel, which could impact the demand, if approved.
