- Posters must be created by the student and reflect and include the title of this year's contest theme: ***"Healthy Forests, Healthy Communities"***
- Poster size can range from 8.5" x 11" up to 12" x 18".
- Students may use paint, crayons, pencils, stickers, markers, or whatever inspires them to create the poster.
- Clearly print student's name, grade, teacher, and school on back of poster.
- We will accept digital submissions (photos or scanned copies of posters) due to Covid-19.
