# Regular Meeting Minutes September 10, 2025

The meeting was held in person at the District office. A virtual link was available.

- 13. Natural Resources Conservation Service Report In addition to the report on file, Allison indicated that the Arrowhead Forest Partnership was a huge contributor to their accomplishments for the year.
- 14. Supervisor & Committee Reports
  - a. Area 3 Fall Meeting September 8 Mora Mark reported there were 23 supervisors and 14 staff representing all 9 SWCDs at the Area 3 Fall Meeting. Paul Fish was elected treasurer. Jake Janski & Barb Omarzu as co-chairs, and Greg as secretary were all re-elected. Chuck Rau, MASWCD representative, gave a report on federal funding. Kari Hedin gave a report on Envirothon; Minnetonka placed 8<sup>th</sup> in the national competition. Area 3 dues are going up to \$650. They voted to dispose of records after 7 years. The next meeting will be June 5<sup>th</sup> at the Cloquet Forestry Center. The tour highlighted conservation practices implemented at a local farm.
  - b. St. Louis River Policy Committee Meeting September 4 Chuck's notes were emailed to board members. Chuck and Anita reported that the committee was advised by RC Boheim at the start of the meeting that it was informational only. The current grant is about 36% spent, with partner allocations ranging from 10-95% spent, all partners feel they are on track to spend the funds by the end of 2026. The second biennia budget is increasing slightly to \$2,239,092. Staff will meet to come up with a budget recommendation that will go to the policy committee and then to each partner board. It is anticipated funding will be requested in the spring.
